

The Barton Center for Diabetes Education, Inc. manages and operates two residential programs, wilderness and adventure programs, a traveling day camp, and a leader-in-training program. Our modern health care center is nestled in 300 acres of woodland in central Massachusetts.

We are interviewing RNs for the following positions: charge, leader in training program, and wilderness adventure programs. The positions are designed to empower nurses and to enrich the experience our campers living with diabetes. A nice blend of teaching and mentorship skills is required to identify and meet the needs of adolescents attending the wilderness and adventure programs as well as the leader-in-training program. The charge nurse position, in addition, requires leadership skills as many of our team are student nurses entering the role of RN. Imagine not only having an impact on the future generation of children with diabetes but also the next generation of nurses.
